

Conservation Landscaping Project Check List

You will be required to provide a copy of the project proposal/estimate provided by your contractor as part of your application.

Project Requirements for Conservation Landscaping:

- Minimum 150 square feet per project area (you may combine areas to reach the total and be considered for reimbursement as ONE project)
- 6" soil de-compaction, 2" soil amendment tilled into de-compacted soil
 - Must be planted with at least 75% native plants
 - Cannot contain plants invasive to Maryland

To receive credit towards the Watershed Protection Fee a project must treat impervious surfaces and have 2"-3" of ponding. Impervious treatment and ponding not required for reimbursement.

For each Conservation Landscaping project please ensure the contractor estimate includes the following:

- Does your Conservation Landscaping treat Impervious Surfaces?
 - If yes, how much:
- Does this Conservation Landscaping have ponding?
 - If yes, what is the depth?
- Which of the following your Conservation Landscaping is addressing:
 - Turf Grass removal
 - Invasive Species Removal
 - Erosion Control
- What is the project cost:
- What is the size of the Conservation Landscape? (Minimum requirement is 150 ft²):
- Where on your property is the project located? (Include detailed written explanation or aerial photo)
